2023 Compact Truck Rules

- 1. Welding from center of front wheels forward permitted. This is the only frame welding allowed.
- 2. Patch and pucker frame. 6" long \(\frac{1}{4} \)" thick plate outside of frame only, 8" between patches.
- 3. No frame swaps. No Imperial subs frames, K frames, ect. Stock only!
- 4. Must use stock front bumper to cover your beam. No factory or homemade pointy bumpers.
- 5. If running a radiator fan, MUST have a hood and must be bolted down in max of six places using max 1" rod, 6" washer max. 12"x12" opening in the hood above the carburetor.
- 6. All doors must be welded or chained shut.
- 7. Roll cages allowed. Inside or outside of the cab. Braces must stay in front of the wheel wells and can be bolted to the frame.
- 8. Dash bar 4" max, door bars and rear cab bars are allowed. 2 down bars to the frame from dash bar allowed. Down bar cannot extend forward past firewall.
- 9. Cab reinforcement must remain separate from the box.
- 10. Gear protection in the box cannot be attached to the cab, box front, sides or rear.
- 11. Tailgate must be welded to the box. Factory tailgates only.
- 12. No stuffing of body panels (fenders, box sides, ect.)
- 13. Rear bumpers that are removed, must have frame rails capped using channel or angle, can extend out to box sides.
- 14. Prior run trucks must meet rules.
- 15. May add an additional eight body bolts total, other than factory locations in cab and box. 6" washer max.
- 16. 4x4's must have front driveshaft removed.
- 17. Dodge Dakota's 2013 and older are allowed. No full-size trucks or frames allowed.
- 18. Motor mounts may be welded. Additional straps or chains can be added. Must be in front of the carburetor.
- 19. 4, 6 cylinders and V-8's allowed.
- 20. Radi-barrels must be inside frame rails (top and bottom), may be welded or bolted in, 4" thick outside to outside max and vented down.
- 21. No homemade spring packs leafs only up to 8 and must be staggered. Can have up to 6 clamps per side.
- 22. Built rims with centers, lip protectors allowed. Any tires including diggers allowed on rear. NO foam on drive wheels. No bead locks or protectors.
